A new front and rear reflector installation procedure has been cut into production as from the units shown below:

DESCRIPTION:

Front and rear reflectors should be installed as explained in the procedure below, to ensure proper adhesion.

PROCEDURE:

1. Preparations:

- Park the coach on a level surface, apply the parking brake and shut down the engine.
- Switch off all systems and turn off the battery master switch.
- Put a "DO NOT OPERATE" tag on the instrument panel.
- Observe safe shop practices at all times.
- Read the entire procedure before beginning to work.




Figure 1 : Amber reflector VH 774405401 (C2045)




Figure 2: Amber reflector VH 774405401 (T2145)

2. To install reflectors VH 774405401 and VH 10712104 (see Figures 1, 2 and 3):




Figure 2 : Red reflector VH 10712104 (C2045)

- 1) Pre-clean the reflector recess in the affected body part by removing all debris and remaining adhesive with a scraper. Avoid damage to painted surfaces.
- 2) Finish-clean with acetone. Surface should be clean, dry, and free of dust, grease and oil.
- 3) Remove the protective strip from the two-sided self-adhesive backing tape of the new reflector. There is no need to remove the backing tape.

 Cover the back of the new reflector with a coat of Sikaflex 221 adhesive or a similar polyurethane adhesive. Coat should be about 5/64 inch (2 mm) thick.
- 4) Install the reflector in the recess, right side up. The text on the reflector lens should be readable. Allow adhesive to cure.

Procedure complete.
