- ☐ Change engine oil and filters, fuel filters.

☐ Driver shades, mirrors, and steering column adjustments.

- ☐ If Detroit or Cummins software is available, perform a forced regen and NOX efficiency test. Check for engine codes.
- ☐ If lift equipped, check fluids, wiring, manual pump, valves, etc., as well cycling the lift, to ensure proper operation.
- ☐ Ensure that all passenger and wheelchair restraint, belts are in the coach.
- ☐ Check Audio and video equipment.
