SUBJECT: Balancing brake drums and hub centered wheels

DESCRIPTION:

In order to properly balance brake drums, or steel or alloy wheel and tire assemblies, it is necessary to center them by the bore, and not by the stud holes (see Figures 1 and 2).





Figures 1 and 2: Wheel and tire assembly installed on a balancer, and centered by the bore.
