#### **DESCRIPTION:**




Figure 1: Steering linkage idler arm # VH R0 10538746 with grease nipple location shown

 Owners and operators of the above-mentioned coaches are requested to check whether the steering linkage idler arm has been equipped with a grease nipple (see Figure 1).
If no grease nipple has been fitted, please contact ABC Customer Care & Parts Source.

- Service records have shown that, after being in service for several years, some of the abovementioned coach models develop idler arm noise while driving.
- To address the issue, Van Hool offer a free replacement idler arm featuring a grease nipple in the housing. These assemblies come pre-lubricated, ready to fit and include detailed fitting instructions.
- Once installed, the idler arm assembly should be thoroughly greased through every 6,000 miles to remove any contaminated grease that may have developed in the period between maintenance intervals.
- Customers with coaches, which are already equipped with an idler arm featuring a grease nipple, are reminded that these assemblies should be lubricated regularly, as stated in the Maintenance Manual.
