DESCRIPTION:

In an effort to enhance driver comfort and safety, the hazard warning flasher electrical circuit has been rewired. As of the units mentioned under "Application," the dash mounted hazard warning flasher switch will illuminate when the exterior lighting is being switched on, improving the visibility of the switch.

The button will glow faintly in the dark when the hazard warning flasher is not in use. It will flash in a normal fashion with the flasher activated.
