APPLICATION:

The new driver's front unit air filter has been cut into production as from the units shown below:

DESCRIPTION:

To facilitate periodical driver's front unit air filter service, the old one-piece model has been replaced in production by a two-piece hinged type. The new design allows the filter to be removed in its entirety from the vehicle, making it easier to either clean the filter gauze or to replace it.

Refer to the procedure in this Bulletin for cleaning/replacement instructions.

PARTS AND PRODUCTS:

New parts

VH 10736678	Filter gauze, cut-to-fit	1

- Old and new parts are interchangeable, but only the new will be offered for service replacement.
- New parts may be purchased from your nearest ABC Customer Care & Parts Source dealership.
- Parts and products disposition: discard according to applicable environmental regulations.

PROCEDURE:

1. General:

- For your information only: the time required to replace the driver's front unit air filter is approximately 0.25 hours.
- There are no specific job requirements to change and/or clean the filter.

2. Special tools, equipment or services:

• No special tools, equipment or services are required.

3. Preparations:

- Park the coach on a level surface with the front wheels straight. Apply the parking brake and shut down the engine.
- Switch off all systems and turn off the battery master switch.
- Put a "DO NOT OPERATE" tag on the instrument panel.
- Read the entire procedure before beginning to work.

CAUTION: Observe safe shop practices at all times.

4. To replace the driver's front unit air filter assembly:

1) Open the door giving access to the windshield washer tank and the driver's compartment HVAC unit (see Figure 1).




Figure 2: Front unit air filter assembly

2) Locate the air filter assembly (Figure 2).




Figure 3: Front unit air filter assembly locked




Figure 4: Front unit air filter assembly unlocked

3) Unlock the winged studs left and right (Figures 3 and 4).

- 4) Pull out the old filter assembly and remove it from the coach.
 - NOTE: To ease removal, the steering wheel fore-aft position may be adjusted.




Figure 5: Filter hinge facing upwards

- 5) Install the new filter with the filter hinge facing upwards (see Figure 5).

- 6) Lock the assembly in the front unit housing.
- 7) Close the access door.

5. To clean the filter gauze:

- 1) Remove the filter gauze from the frame.
- 2) Shake out excessive dirt and grit.
- 3) Wash in luke-warm water and if extremely dirty, use a mild laundry or dishwasher detergent.
- 4) Rinse with clean water and shake out excessive water. Do not wring or squeeze. Be sure gauze is completely dry before installing.
- 5) Reinstall gauze in filter frame.

6. To replace the driver's front unit air filter gauze:

- 1) Remove the filter assembly from the driver's front unit.
- 2) Fold the filter.




Figure 6: Filter gauze back-up frame

- 3) Slide-out the filter gauze back-up frames one by one (see Figure 6).

- 4) Remove the old gauze.
- 5) Cut new filter gauze to size.
- 6) Install the new gauze.
- 7) Reinsert the back-up frames.
- 8) Reinstall the filter assembly in the driver's front unit.

Procedure complete.
