INTRODUCTION

Due to an increase of electrical loads in today's vehicles, it is more important than ever for drivers to response in the proper way should any of the battery symbols shown below, appear while the vehicle is in operation. This will help prevent possible damage to other components of the vehicle electrical system. Please review the following information:

ALTERNATOR FAILURE MESSAGES

Symbol	Message	Action required
T 1 T	Alternator No.1 does not	Switch off as many unimportant power consumers
	supply power	as possible and drive to the nearest repair shop.
2 • 000	Alternator No.2 does not	Switch off as many unimportant power consumers
	supply power	as possible and drive to the nearest repair shop.
***************************************	Alternator No.3 does not supply power	Switch off as many unimportant power consumers as possible and drive to the nearest repair shop.

WHICH POWER CONSUMERS CAN BE SWITCHED OFF?

- 120Vac electrical system*
- HVAC
- Kitchenette electrical system*
- Refrigerator*
- Electric devices added after delivery to the vehicle*
- Interior lighting (If it doesn't influence safety!)
